Apostolic: To train the man in the Youth Apostles relational ministry style, in a pre-existing ministry and under the direct supervision of a youth apostle youth minister and/or campus minister. There will be regular feedback and opportunity for increased leadership and responsibility throughout the course of the year.

Spiritual: To help the man grow in holiness: centered in the Eucharist, participation in a daily holy hour and Liturgy of the Hours with the Consecrated members of the community, and regular spiritual direction.

Communal: To help the man appreciate the gift of communal living and brotherly care in one of our Youth Apostles Houses. To actively participate in all house activities, including meals, prayer, house meetings, chores and small group sharing. The House Director will mentor the new resident and meet with him at regular intervals.

Formative: To help the man learn more about the faith, the Church and the Youth Apostles charism through reading, reflection and intellectual faith formation talks and activities. Specifically to grow in knowledge and skill in youth ministry through studies and participation in the formation program of the community.

Youth Apostles provides

- A \$200 Monthly stipend
- Free room and board
- Gas expenses and regular car maintenance
- Car and health insurance (if needed)
